Accessing Distance Learning for Mathematics

The Mathematics Department have produced a mirrored curriculum so that learning from home aligns with the lessons being taught in school. This will ensure that all students, whether they are at home or in school, will be covering the same material at the same time.

Distance learning – Absence due to illness or self-isolation/ Absence due to bubble working at home

Years 7 and 8 will need to access their learning at home through Satchel 1 (Show My Homework) and Microsoft SharePoint, where the White Rose Maths scheme of learning has been fully uploaded and correlates with what is being covered in school. Answer sheets will be available for students to mark their own learning as they progress through the lessons. This immediate feedback should provide them with confidence with their progress, or help identify misconceptions in their learning. If, at any point, they need further support, they should contact their class teacher using the email address provided below.

Years 9, 10 and 11 will need to access their learning through their CGP online Mathematics book, using their unique 16-digit code. This has already been issued for use. Additionally, these year groups will need to follow the lesson information uploaded on Satchel 1 (Show My Homework). The activities set on Satchel 1 are linked to the CGP online Mathematics book and correlates with what is being covered in school. Like the books used in school, the answers to tasks can be found in the online resource. As is regular practice in lessons, students should mark their work as they complete it. This immediate feedback should provide them with confidence with their progress or help identify misconceptions in their learning. If, at any point, they need further support, they should contact their class teacher using the email address provided below.

Each year group has a set of clear 'Distance Learning' instructions that can be found on Satchel 1. Students should follow these instructions, using the links, if required, to other online platforms specific to the lesson(s). All students can still access MyMaths, JustMaths, corbettmaths.com etc. to further support them.

In addition to this, whether at the academy or learning from home, all students are still expected to complete their weekly homework set by their class teacher.

We hope that this mirrored curriculum, and the accompanying resources, will support your child to continue their education in Mathematics, under these unusual circumstances.
