## Geography Field Trip to North and South Coast - Thursday 19 March 2015

I am arranging a day of organised fieldwork comparing the South coast at Seaton and Downderry with the North coast at Treyarnon and Porthcothan for the Year 11 GCSE Geography students. The coach will leave the Academy at 8:30am and return by 3:10pm in time for buses.

It must be emphasised that the day will be hard work, and will involve a lot of walking; not a day of beach games! The fieldwork will contribute to the students' understanding of the GCSE Paper 1 'Physical Geography' Section B; Water on the Land, and The Coastal Zone, as well as various data collection skills.

Students should equip themselves with a clipboard (or hard-backed file), pen, pencil, and a plastic bag. Sensible casual clothing and sturdy shoes or wellie boots should be worn. Students should be prepared for a range of weather, (probably windy, wet or cold, or all three!) and will need to bring a packed lunch and a digital camera, 35mm camera with film, or a camera phone, if possible.

The cost of travel will be £2.00 each and it would be appreciated if you could make a contribution; in accordance with current regulations, participation is by voluntary contribution and clearly if insufficient funds are raised in this manner then the trip will not be able to take place.
