1. Thank you to all staff who helped with the Ex-Year 11 informal reunion and certificate presentation evening, in particular to Mrs Smith. The evening went very well with 80% student attendance. We were pleased to hear of some very positive news from our ex-students.
2. Thank you to Mr Kevern and Year 10 tutors for last week's Parents' Evening, please ensure that any issues are followed up. Thanks too to Mr George for his Diploma presentation to parents.
3. Thank you for smooth Mock exam week for Year 11. Results should be entered in to Assessment Manager by 7th January. No results should be issued to students until the formal issue of results on 13th January when we will have a 'Mock results' day.
4. Many thanks to Friends of Looe Community School for organising the Key Stage 3 disco, in particular to Mrs Darlington.

5. Behaviour Management – corridors should be clear of students who disrupt lessons or set a poor example. If there is any doubt that a student will go directly to reception following S4 or S5 please send the referral slip with a responsible student to reception who will radio for back-up.
6. Continue to re-enforce uniform rules. On the whole uniform was very good last week, but T-shirts creeping above necklines need tackling please. T-shirts under shirts because students are not wearing fleece is unacceptable. Tutors – please pass names of students without a fleece to LCOs.
7. Notes from Middle Leadership Team meeting 30/11/10
 - Agreed that staff should update students' KS4 data in Assessment Manager when data changes so we have a "Looe Live" database. This will inform tracking of progress to targets.
 - Changes to courses information in the Options booklet for curriculum 2011 to Mrs Willars please.
 - Next year's Curriculum (2011-12) Travel and Tourism Diploma will be added to choices; options will be blocked in advance; uneconomical class sizes will not be run (less than 12); off-site courses may be reduced if diploma funding insufficient; timetable may run over two weeks and staff teaching loads could increase to 45/50 across two weeks.
 - SIMS Learning Gateway will be established in January allowing access to SIMS from home. Reports will be entered in directly, exporting data to pen drives will no longer be used. Future reports will be written from the PROFILES module, comment banks will need updating. Parents will be able to access some student data from home. Year 11 will continue as current practice.
 - Draft Assessment Policy re-circulated. Presentation and marking guidance needs to be considered by all departments and returned to Mr Keveth. Tracking data policy needs to be added. Comments to Mr Keveth please.
 - Performance Management – Training will be offered in Spring Term to MLT. Policy which has union approval (TEACHER.net Sep 2009) will be circulated. Changes are (1) post –threshold process; (2) one of three lesson observations will be conducted by member of SLT, as per my announcement in September
 - Formal lesson observations of all staff by SLT will start in January. Notice will be given.

9. As previously notified on 21st September, a Teaching & Learning meeting will take place on Tuesday 14th December. This was omitted from the calendar, but will be taking place as planned
