- 2. Thank you to staff for their support with the student photographs last week. These are now available for parents/carers to order.
- 3. Thank you to staff and students for their help or support with the production of the new Academy prospectus last week. This will be circulated to feeder primary schools ahead of the Open Evening.
- 4. It was a privilege on Friday for all of us to meet and hear Paralympian Talan Skeels-Piggins tell us his story as part of this year's launch of the Be the Best you can Be programme. Talan spent the day meeting students and helping students to identify their goals. Thank you to Mrs Casson for coordinating. We look forward to his return visit when we will share our journeys with him.
- 5. As part of the drive to close the gap and raise achievement twenty Year 11 students will be taking part in a 6 week intensive literacy intervention programme 'Sound Training'. The programme focuses on improving students' vocabulary, understanding and decoding ability. Schools report the average reading gain after one hour per week for six weeks is more than 24 months. They also note improvements in students' motivation, self-confidence and engagement in lessons. The programme begins this Thursday; further details have been sent to all teaching staff.
- 6. Last week the SE Cornwall secondary schools released a joint press release announcing our intentions to work closely with the police and their dogs in order to continue to keep our school communities safe. The police will lead assemblies on how they use their dogs in their work to seek out drugs.

- 7. The Looe Music Festival is being held this weekend, September 19 th. Safety at the festival will feature in two assemblies this week and parents will be informed of our concerns. The Police will be delivering the first assembly to students in Years 10 and 11 on Monday morning to inform them about safety during the festival this year and this will be revisited in Thursday to all students.
- 8. This week representative s of the Academy Trust will be meeting DFE representatives with other local schools to explore the implications and possibilities of potential Multi-Academy Trust status; this is one avenue of partnership working to ensure the sustainability of quality education in the Looe and Rame Peninsula.
- 9. Advance notice that Open Evening this year will be on Thursday 25 September followed by Open days by appointment on Monday 29 September and Tuesday 30 September. We look forward to welcoming prospective new students and their families. In readiness for this would all departments let me know their programmes for their areas by Wednesday this week.
