4. The recent Green Paper proposes changes to SEN arrangements which means that the parent will be at the centre of their child's provision. This is also at a time of reduced funding and many parents will be anxious about withdrawal of funding and classroom support that their have fought hard to obtain. As parents will be concerned about these changes, it is important that we manage this process and their fears and reassure them that we expect to deliver first class provision and to meet their needs regardless of any change to funding. This is because we believe that every child has a right to a first class education and quality first teaching and believe in achievement for all. We will be looking for input from staff on how they are meeting the needs and closing the gap for SEND and Pupil Premium students. Through the SEN Reviews, Mr Damerell will focus particularly on the parents' perceptions of what their child needs, which will be much more in the spirit of the Green paper.
