2. We look forward to the RAF STEM Roadshow visiting Year 8 students on Monday. 'Fun with Flight' is a 50-minute jet fuelled presentation exploring the physics of flying. Students will discover how the physics they study in the classroom is an integral part of the work that engineers undertake in the RAF and other engineering organisations. This will take place in the Sports Hall during period 3, supported by Science and PE.
