Positive Futures

We have secured a range of independent experts, including colleges, universities, businesses and apprenticeship providers to share their knowledge of further and higher education and employment-based training and to discuss the range of post-16 pathways, the choices available and the grades (now known as levels) and entry requirements for each of these. There will be experts on hand to discuss routes beyond school as well as support for the Year 10 work experience programme.

Information about possible education, training and career pathways will be available throughout the evening through 20 minute presentations by our exhibitors. A timetable of these will be available on the night. You are welcome to come along at any point during this event but be aware that the presentation below starts at 5.40pm.

Key to Success presentation (5.40pm)

This is designed to empower you with a toolkit that will help your child to reach their potential and 'Be the Best they can Be'. Revision preparation is vital, with recent Year 10 and 11 mocks underway, it is now time for your child to really reflect on themselves as learners and prepare themselves well for their final GCSE and BTEC examinations, so that their next steps into post-16 destinations open up many new horizons and provide much choice in lifelong learning. Revision experts will be on hand to advise you about how you can support your child with revision timetables and proven revision techniques. The presentation will also include information about post-16 education, careers guidance and future residential employability skills opportunities.

Evidence suggests that parent/carers engagement in a child's education can add three months extra progress to a student's grades; there is no doubt that attending this evening will advantage your child's educational experience and outcomes in the run up to their exams.
