Our students will appear at Plymouth Crown Court in front of a real judge, and will prosecute and defend cases against other schools. We have been practicing two cases, a theft and fraud, and a grievous bodily harm. All witnesses have had to learn two parts and the lawyers have had to prepare to prosecute or defend both cases.
