Positive Futures (4-6pm)

We have secured a range of independent experts, including colleges, universities and apprenticeship providers to share their knowledge of further and higher education and employment-based training and to discuss the range of post-16 pathways, the choices available and the grades (now known as levels) and entry requirements for each of these.

Information about possible education, training and career pathways will be available. You are welcome to come along at any point during this event but be aware that the presentation below starts at 5pm.

Key to Success presentation (5pm)

This is designed to empower you with a toolkit that will help your child to reach their potential and 'Be the Best they can Be'.
