Health, Safety and Wellbeing - Taking Students Off Site

We are fortunate to offer students wider experiences and opportunities to learn away from the Academy, but this needs to be carefully managed to ensure that their learning is not disrupted and that they are kept safe.

Staff are required to follow the well-established educational visits process; a good starting point is the Educational Visits folder on the Admin Shared Documents area.

The checklist (see folder "Forms") will guide you through the process, which starts by securing SLT approval for the activity. Once approved there are a number of key stages that need to be followed, including submission of the Educational Visits form, undertaking risk assessments, securing parental consent and providing a copy of all supporting documents to SLT emergency contacts.

If in doubt about any part of the process, please see a member of SLT.

- 1. The last opportunity for Year 11 to be together as a year group will be this Friday. Students will have a special assemblies and will also have the chance to celebrate their last day with a celebratory BBQ. Year 11 students, with their parents'/carers' permission, are able to leave at 2.30pm on that day. Students who catch a bus will of course be able to stay until the end of the day. From Monday 18 June study arrangements will be altered and your child will be expected to attend school only for examinations or for revision sessions. Private study rooms available exclusively for Year 11 are the Small Hall and Library, where there are also computer facilities. Year 11 will be expected to sign in and out of the building at Student Services each day they attend school.
- 2. Thank you to Mrs Reynolds for running the Alumni Rothschild project and the Year 10 Citizenship Looe Plastic awareness launch last week.
- 3. Thank you to Mrs Feldberg and Mr Sheer for accompanying students to The Contemporary Craft Festival in Devon last Friday. This was a fabulous opportunity to see textiles, ceramics and mixed media work by over 200 of the UK's best designer makers. The focus of the trip was to extend students' knowledge of the designer maker world and to extend their own aspirations in their own textiles creative coursework.

- 4. Thank you to Mr Sheer and the PE department for arranging the Basketball Festival last week for pupils from local primary schools.
- 5. On Thursday we welcome representatives from the Royal Navy who will deliver a 'Can't Cook, Won't Cook' session to some of our Food Technology students. Students will get a short talk about life in the Royal Navy and then working in teams, be given a bag of ingredients and shown how to cook a meal with a Navy chef.
- 6. This week we welcome back ex-student Bobbie-Lea Baker who is on her first year of a three year secondary Mathematics Teacher Training Degree at Manchester Metropolitan University. She will be here on Tuesday this week to gain experience in a school setting.

- 8. Thank you to the staff who have used the IRIS Connect system. There will be an extra IRIS coaching opportunity this week. This device and software will be used for videoing lessons for the purpose of staff development and school improvement.
