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1. Please note that Monday is an INSET day and therefore the Academy will be closed to students. Students are promoted to their new tutor groups and year groups on their return on Tuesday. Current Year 7 will then be called Year 8 etc. However, new Year 10 students will wear blue shirts until September.
2. Thank you to Professor Robin Banerjee who joined us last Tuesday to lead INSET on Sociograms. Professor Banerjee is Professor of Developmental Psychology at the University of Sussex, where he directs the CRESS (Children's Relationships, Emotions, and Social Skills) Research Lab. We were also pleased to be able to support other schools by offering this training both to our staff and to primary, secondary and HE colleagues across Cornwall and Devon. Thank you to Mrs Jackman for arranging the day.
3. Thank you to Paralympian, Talan Skeels-Piggins who returned last Friday for our 'Be the Best you can Be' celebration event. Talan is a British alpine skier who uses a sit-ski in competitions. He is a former Royal Navy fighter controller. He was paralysed from the chest down following a motorcycle accident in March 2003, which shattered his spine and broke his neck. After his injury he was retained in the Armed Forces and serves as a Lieutenant in the Royal Naval. In 2010 he won two bronze medals at the NorAm Cup in Kimberly, Canada to secure his qualification for the 2010 Winter Paralympics. In 2011 Talan founded The Bike Experience, a charity established to help motorcycle riders who are now paraplegic to ride again. He is also the 600 cc World Motorcycle Champion for disabled competitors. Year 7 students spent time with Talan sharing their presentations of their achievements and commitments this year.
4. On Thursday we will be joined by local artists Hayley Buscombe and Vicky Wiltshire who will work with a group of Key Stage 3 students to create Gyotaku prints as part of their Arts Award. Gyotaku (Japanese 魚拓, from gyo "fish" + taku "rubbing") is the traditional Japanese method of printing fish, a practice which dates back to the mid-1800s. This form of nature printing may have been used by fishermen to record their catches, but has also become an artform of its own.

5. Students' work will be displayed at the CreatEd Exhibition at Falmouth University this week. The categories are Textiles, Art, Resistant Materials and Engineering. The exhibition runs from Thursday 25 June until 4 July 2015. Mr Langdon Mrs Rowe, Mr George and Mr Long will set our displays up on Wednesday.
6. On Thursday we will be joined by Sam Kelly who will deliver an assembly to let students know about the Looe Music Festival Songwriter of the Year 2015 competition. This competition run by the Looe Music Festival and the Arts Council is a project to encourage young musical talent in the local area. Under notices are further details about this competition with a professional recording as a prize and the opportunity to hear their own song performed at the Looe Festival in September. Sam reached the Britain's Got Talent finals in 2012 and has been recording and performing around the country ever since and enjoys visiting schools to encourage young talent.
7. Well done to the four students who will represent the Academy at Cornwall Sports Partnership's School Games on Friday which will be held in St Austell.
8. We look forward to the Class of 2015 Prom at the Hannafore Point Hotel on Friday. For the past two years we have operated a traffic management system to maintain traffic flow during the arrival of students in their wonderful array of vehicles; this has received much praise from the local community so we will be operating a similar system this year. We expect traffic levels to start to increase from about 6pm as parents, carers, family members and onlookers start to gather to celebrate the arrival of the students between 6:30 and 7:15pm. Prom drivers have been advised to proceed past the Hotel and follow a big loop along Marine Drive and back to the Hotel via Portuan Road. There will be a designated lay-by outside the Hotel for Prom vehicles so that local traffic can continue to flow. The Looe Lions have kindly offered their support to help with traffic management and we look forward to working with them again this year to make the event run as smoothly as possible for the whole community.
