GCSE PE Practical Curriculum

Lifesaving

Personal survival is a key element of the GCSE practical curriculum, owing to the positive grades that are obtained by the students. The sessions will take place at Tencreek Holiday Park swimming pool during curriculum time. In order for the students to benefit from this, the requirements are as follows:

- Each week during their time at Tencreek students will complete 1 hour 30 minutes in the swimming pool.
- Students will be required to wear swim clothing and have spare suitable clothes to wear. I have explained to them in full the type of clothing that is most suitable and light weight.
- The lifesaving sessions will cost £3.50 per session, totalling £10.50 for three sessions.

Orienteering

Orienteering is a new activity that we will be delivering to help students gain high practical marks. The sessions will take place in at Saltram, Plymbridge and Central Park in Plymouth, during curriculum time. In order for the students to benefit from this, the requirements are as follows:

- Each week students will complete an orienteering course.
- Students will be required to wear their full PE kit, and must bring warm clothes.

This will commence on Thursday 12 January 2017. Students will be split into two groups and will be transported to either Tencreek pool or their orienteering course in Plymouth at 12.45pm; after three weeks the two groups will change. Students will return for buses as usual.
