8. On Monday we begin our CLEAR (Children Linked with and Experiencing Abusive Relationships) programme with Year 8 and Year 9 students. The programme aims to promote healthy relationships and give students an understanding of what is an unhealthy relationship. The programme will be led by qualified therapists who specialise in working with children and young people; they will be able to support the emotional wellbeing of the students both in the workshops and after the sessions finish.

9. Well done to students who completed their final Psychology Super Learning Day on Saturday, in preparation for their upcoming GCSE exam. Students have shown excellent commitment and work ethic in this enrichment subject, attending after school lessons and completing many hours of independent study.
