In the recent White Paper, the Government announced that all schools should have their MAT partners identified by 2020. Whilst not law, and some way off, we believe there are benefits to working collaboratively so are now undertaking due diligence and the business case for this, with a view to becoming part of SMART, likely to be renamed South East Cornwall Multi Academy Regional Trust in 2017
