If anyone in the Academy is in need of support surrounding this incident please inform a member of the SLT as we will be working with other agencies to support as necessary.

3. Thank you to Mr Gilbert and Miss Cox for accompanying students to the Big Bang STEM event at City College Plymouth last Tuesday.
4. Thank you to Mrs Birkbeck and Mr Kevern for accompanying students to the performances of 'Hitler on Trial' and 'The Doctors Show' last week. This will be supported by a session on "exam busting", which aims to unpack the requirements of different styles of questions. The aims of the session are to help students develop their understanding of the use of evidence, to promote their understanding

of causation, to develop their ability to analyse historical arguments and to help them to revise factual information.
