Staff teaching Year 11 will continue to be available for normal timetabled lessons until the date of the last exam, should students choose to attend for additional support.

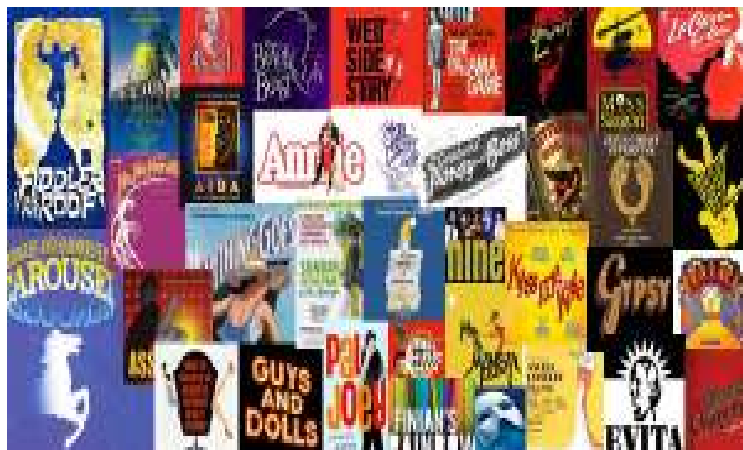
