2. A big thank you to all the staff and students who contributed to the Christmas celebrations at the end of last term which included the Christmas Concert, Christmas lunch, Reflection assembly and Nativity and the traditional end of term Show. Thank you for raising £377.11 on the last day of term.
3. Thank you to Mrs Palmer, Mr Pilling and Mr Keveith for delivering INSET sessions on Monday this week. This term's Literacy focus on Writing will be on use of commas and full stops.
4. Would staff please ensure that they sign and return the form to say that they have read and understood the 'Code of Conduct for Staff in Academic Settings' documents circulated last term.
5. Year 11 Parents'/Carers' evening takes place this Thursday. The evening for Year 10 will take place next Thursday.
6. On 27 December the Academy commenced a consultation on its Admissions process. Full details are on the school website. This is to consider how places to the Academy will be allocated to students in the event of oversubscription. All contributions are welcome
7. Would teachers ensure that any outstanding SEN paperwork is passed to Mrs White no later than Thursday this week in preparation for the SEN Reviews which begin next week for KS4.
8. On Thursday the GCSE mathematics results from the exam sat in November will be issued to Year 11 at 11.35am in the Small Hall along with a formal communication on the results of mock exams. This will follow an extended break for the candidates who are sitting their English exam. Year 10 results will be issued in lessons by their subject teachers.
9. Advance notice that the teachers' staff meeting next week will focus on the IRIS Connect system. This device and software will be for used for videoing lessons for the purpose of staff development and school improvement. A policy will be developed alongside to ensure correct use and storage of any material which will be used for training purposes and support.
10. The next INSET session on Tuesday 5 February will focus on Literacy and Reading.
11. This term's PSHCE focus is on 'Stay Safe'. National E-Safety Day is 5 February. We will be holding training for staff and information session for parents and carers on 14 March on this important subject by a National trainer.

12. Would tutors please remind students about the Exam Zone/one way system and the rules and procedures associated with this. This will be in operation on Wednesday and Thursday this week. Be aware of signs and silence around exam zone.
13. Our strict uniform code will continue this term. Non-compliance with uniform code will result in students not being taught in normal lessons until a way forward is found.

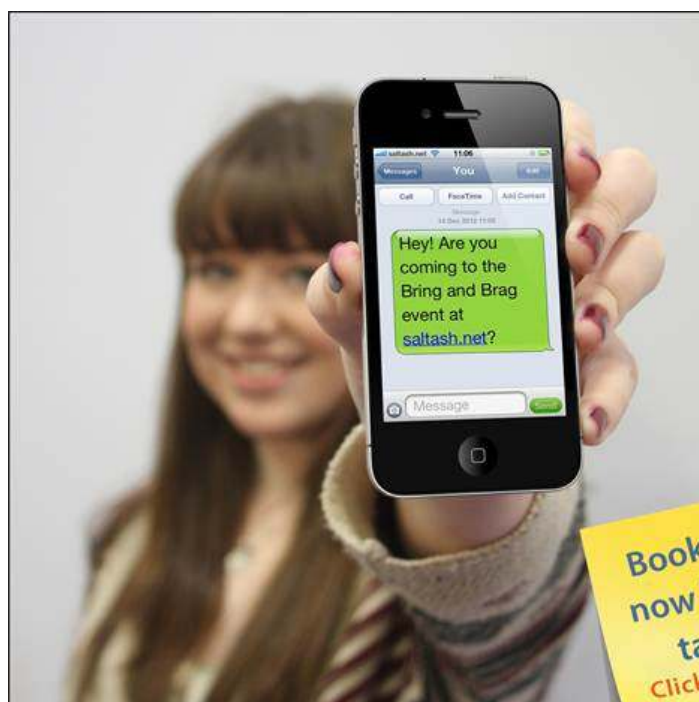
