3. On Tuesday last week five Year 10 students took part in an Engineering challenge at RNAS Culdrose in Helston. The idea being that it simulated a real helicopter crash landing in a remote area. Of course, the students had limited time and materials in order to design and make their solution. Their ideas were very original and creative and many Navel Engineers commented positively about how well they worked as a team. Unfortunately, at the end they were beaten by some of the twelve teams taking part from other Cornish schools. The team consisting of Charlie Seddon, Jessica Hughes, Ross McGregor, Thomas McLaren and Nathan Frankland also had the opportunity to tour the naval base and were shown where and how the pilots and engineers were trained.
