Once approved there are a number of key stages that need to be followed, including submission of the Educational Visits form, undertaking risk assessments, securing parental consent and providing a copy of all supporting documents to SLT emergency contacts.</p> <p>If in doubt about any part of the process, please see a member of SLT.</p>
