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#### **Year 11 Revision and Pre Exam Meeting Timetable Arrangements**

**Year 11 Timetable Arrangements** from Monday 9 May 2016 are to include pre exam meetings, in addition to the after school and lunch time revision sessions available to students, as negotiated by teacher and subject areas. **PLEASE DO NOT USE THIS AS YOUR EXAMINATION TIMETABLE**

Lessons remain as timetabled unless an exam has been completed; in this instance students have to attend lessons as stated below. If there are no alternative lessons, students must remain in normal lessons and be encouraged to revise using strategies from the year 11 revision day.

If students have an exam in the morning, all students in the exam must register in the small hall for an early start, between 8:30 and 8:40, before taking part in a **Formal Pre- Exam Meeting** led by a Subject Specialist.

**A general morning before an exam will look like this:**

**8:00 – 8:30 Breakfast and Revision Club** in the small hall available for all students who have a morning exam. Students are reminded to bring all of their equipment needed for their exam and revision notes. Bags and mobile phones should be placed in lockers before registering.

**8:30 – 8:40 Registration** All students taking a morning exam must be registered between 8:30 and 8:40 in the small hall. Revision notes can be collected from the small hall after the exam.

**8:40 – 9:05 Formal Pre- Exam Meeting** take place, led by subject specialist. Revision notes can be left in the small hall and collected after the exam.

**9:05 – Students make their way to the gallery** in preparation for their exam.

**\*\*\* Formal Pre-Exam Meetings will occur before afternoon exams from 13:00 – 13:30 in the small hall, and will be led by subject specialists.**
