9. Data protection laws are changing next month when the new General Data Protection Regulations come in to force on 25 May 2018. GDPR incorporates much of what we currently need to do to appropriately collect, use, manage, share and protect personal data. The legislation will tighten up certain aspects and will introduce new responsibilities to deal with a data-rich environment that simply did not exist on this scale when the previous legislation came in to force in 1998. Staff are to ensure they are aware of their responsibilities and the Academy's expectations when collecting, using, managing, sharing and protecting personal information by reading the weekly bite-size updates to inform or refresh knowledge of data protection.
