Governors have listened to views and taken note of the documents which have been presented to them. There are risks involved in both, however, the risk with staying with the LA is considered to be greater due to the threat of redundancies. Therefore the Governors have voted overwhelmingly at their meeting last week in favour of pursuing Academy status. However, the DfE have to agree and give us a funding agreement which is suitable. If staff would like to discuss any of this further directly with Governors they will be in school at 3.30pm on Wednesday 25 May.
