Royal Society Exhibition Trip – 2-3 July 2015

Further to my last letter regarding the trip to the Royal Society Exhibition, I am pleased to now give you a full itinerary.

Thursday 2 July 2015

23:10 Students arrive at Liskeard station on the Plymouth bound platform.
23:25 Board the Riviera Express. Students will be directed to their cabin, given some time to settle in, then it's lights out.

Friday 3 July 2015

06:00 Arrive at Paddington and be awoken for breakfast. We will have an hour at Paddington to use washrooms and get second breakfast if needed.
07:30–10:00 We will get on the Tube and do some sightseeing, stopping off at Trafalgar Square and a possible walk down the Mall to Buckingham Palace.
10:00–12:00 Visit the Natural History Museum for a couple of hours.
13:00–15:00 Visit the exhibition at the Royal Society.
16:00 Return to Paddington station, boarding the 18:03 train.
21:45 Arrive Liskeard Station where students will be met by parents/carers.

The cost of the trip was originally estimated to be £95, but we did not know the exact cost at that time; this will now be £105 which includes the sleeper train and London Underground pass. In accordance with current regulations, participation is by voluntary contribution, and clearly if insufficient funds are raised in this manner then the trip will not be able to take place. Please complete and return the attached medical consent form and return it to Student Services.

The students will need light weight clothes as London can be warm in July. They will need a **small** bag with overnight sleeping clothes and some packed lunches if they are not planning to buy food, but please note that breakfast is included in the cost of the train ticket. Please also pack a lightweight waterproof coat in case it should rain. They do not need to wear Academy uniform.
