- 8 **Cashless System** - Thank you to students and staff for their patience as we transitioned to our new cashless system in the canteen last week.

Chartwells canteen staff had to learn the new touch screen tills, which record each product purchased, and this slowed down the process while they got to grips with the new system. However, the benefit for students, parents and carers is that these purchases can now be analysed via the student's ParentPay account, prompting discussions about healthy eating and improving nutrition over time. Please continue to be sympathetic towards the till operators

while they are learning a new system.

Free school meals - students access the system in the same way as non-FSM students, providing anonymity. They automatically receive £2.30 per day on their account for food only - not for drinks, as water and cups are provided. Any unspent allocation cannot be carried forward, and the FSM account is reset to £2.30 the next day. Students can top up their account with cash to purchase additional items beyond their daily £2.30 allowance, as long as the total spend remains within the daily spend limit set by their parents/carers.

Daily spend limit - the default spend is £3.50 per day to provide parents/carers with some protection having pre-paid for the week/month; this can be changed at any time by parents/carers in writing. Students need to have the conversation with their parents/carers if they feel their daily limit is too restrictive.

Ways to pay - parents/carers have three new options: credit/debit card online via ParentPay; PayPoint at local stores; by cheque made payable to Chartwells (hand in to Canteen staff). Ask Mr Green for more details.

Loading cash at the machine - the canteen is open from 0800 for Breakfast Club; the machine can be accessed before the school day to load cash or check balances to reduce the queue at break and lunch.

Using the thumb scanners - place the thumb squarely on the scanner and press hard and hold until system acknowledges.

Visitors - staff need to let Mr Green know if they have visitors that need to be registered on the system
