- 1. Thank you to all who welcomed the CEO candidates last week. Following the appointment process Kate Waghorn, Chair of the SMART Trust said "I am delighted to inform you that the Trust Board have appointed Dan Buckley to the role of CEO of SMART. This decision was taken after a robust two day appointments procedure which took account of the feedback received from Headteachers, Chairs of Governors, governors who met the candidates and the Student Council. Dan demonstrated his extensive experience over a wide range of educational based projects which he has undertaken in a variety of contexts over a number of years. The Trust Board are looking forward to working with Dan to bring alive the vision, values and ethos of SMART for the benefit of young people in South East Cornwall."
- 2. On Friday I met with Sherryl Murray, MP in order to discuss the implications of lack of funding and the Government's funding formula on our Academy. David Barton, CASH Executive Officer also gave examples of other schools. She listened most attentively and sympathetically and assured me of her support. I hope that she and the other Cornish MPs take the message to the Government who need to hear it from their MPs as well as from teachers, parents, unions and local authorities.
- 3. Year 9 students are reminded that preliminary Option choices must be made by completing, detaching and returning the form at the back of their Options Booklet to Student Services by Monday this week.
- 4. We look forward to the Class of 2017 Record of Achievement evening on Tuesday. Our guest speaker this year this will be former student Pete Greenwood who is a Nuclear Physicist.
- 5. In light of changes to GCSE examinations and the need for our students to have high literacy skills, we have launched an academy-wide focus on literacy and invested in a new webbased programme called 'Accelerated Reader' for students in Years 7 and 8. This will help us encourage, manage and monitor students' independent reading through a system of levelled books and computer based comprehension quizzes. All parents and carers of students in Years 7 and 8 are invited an evening workshop and presentation this Wednesday at 7pm. During the evening, we will provide an overview of the programme and share ways in which you can also use this tool to help your child to become a better reader and ultimately enjoy greater examination success.

- 6. Thank you to Mr Sheer and the Year 9 Sports Leaders for planning, leading and organising the Key Stage 1 PE Festival. Learners from all our primary feeder schools developed physical literacy through sporting challenges and healthy competition, the day was a real success and brought about camaraderie between pupils across the schools.
- 7. Good luck to Miss Cox who will be competing in the World pilot gig championships on the Isles of Scilly next weekend
