Bulletin Notices from Miss Jenkins

1. Academy status – I am researching the implications and procedures required for Academy status. This will be discussed over the next term with the Governing body and I will keep you informed throughout the process. The major implication for staff is that if the school becomes an Academy, the Governing Body becomes the employer of staff, rather than Cornwall Council. The Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations (TUPE) protects employees' terms and conditions of employment when a business is transferred from one owner to another. Employees of the previous owner when the business changes hands automatically become employees of the new employer on the same terms and conditions. It's as if their employment contracts had originally been made with

- the new employer. Continuity of service and any other rights are all preserved. Both old and new employers are required to inform and consult employees affected directly or indirectly by the transfer. The earliest we could become an Academy is September.
- 2. The SLT are looking closely at the GCSE mock examination results and how the school can now support students. Maths results at this stage of the year following early entry are pleasing. A curriculum evening to help parents to support their child will be organised soon for each year group.
- 3. Please continue to support Mrs Stammers with examinations this week. Students should be reminded of the need to keep away from the reception and exam area during examinations.
- 4. The Subject Review Meetings started last week with the Science department and concludes on Thursday.
- 5. I am arranging for an external review of Assessment for Learning for the second half of the school year, from February with a report in the summer term. This will involve all Leaders of Learning of Departments doing some lesson observations of their departments with support from external advisers.
- 6. Year 7 and 8 tutors, please make sure any issues are followed up following the Parents' Evening last week.
- 7. School fields continue to be out of bounds unless for lessons due to muddy conditions.
- 8. An interview will take place on Thursday for the position of Examinations Officer.
- 9. Mr Saddler will be organising Safeguarding training for new staff joining us this term. If you have missed Tier 2 Safeguarding training please let him know so that you are up to date on the next round.
