Kit List

- Packed lunch.

- **Spare change of clothes including a warm top.** We had huge fun last year and most got very wet! Some children came without spare clothes and were very cold as a consequence.
- Water shoes e.g. Surf shoes, Crocs, old trainers, but no flip flops please
- Towel
- Coat/Rain Jacket
- **Sun Cream** (Apply before coming and remember to bring it with you so that you can re-apply if it's hot).
- Any medication that you need (please put this in a clear plastic bag with clear instructions on dosage and remember to include the details on the consent form too).

Important Notes for Parents and Children

- Providing the conditions and weather are suitable, we will be paddling in the river. <u>All</u>
 <u>children will need to wear suitable footwear to paddle and get wet in!</u> Please don't forget
 this as children won't be able to paddle if they don't have something on their feet!
 <u>No shoes, no water activity.</u>
- For health and safety reasons you will need to register your child with me in the morning and pick them up from me in the afternoon. Please <u>do not</u> wait in the car park for children to come to you.
- We have organised both in-door and out-door activities so there will be plenty to do
 whatever the weather. There is going to be a mix of creative activities, problem solving
 activities and beach game activities.

Boat Building

The main theme of the day is going to be focussed around 'Boat Building'. The children will get the chance to work as a team to design and build a boat. Once they have designed and built the team boat, they can also have the opportunity to design and build an individual boat. Team and individual boats will then be put to the ultimate test in a race down the river! The children will be encouraged to work with children from different schools in order for them to start building relationships with people they will meet when they start at Looe Community Academy in September.

Materials that can be used
