6. The refurbishment of the ICT rooms 006 and 116 is almost complete. Students should be able to use 006 as part of timetabled ICT lessons from Monday.
7. The conversion to Academy status is being considered by many Governing bodies in Cornwall, with nine secondary schools expected to be Academies from April 1st. On Monday evening, Academy conversion will be the theme of the Governors' training evening with speakers Dean Ashton, Business Consultant and Project Manager (Academy Conversions)

and Andrew Fielder, Principal of Sandy Hill Academy. Looe Learning Forum with Governors will also meet with Dean and Andrew on Monday.

8. This week I met with representative of the LA and Barrett Homes to consider the impact of the proposed footpath along two sides of the school grounds and discussed various compensation schemes. I have expressed concern over the loss of privacy and security of the site, in addition to the loss of land. It is a difficult issue, as the site with affordable homes and business units is very much needed for the community of Looe and we wish to work with the developers to secure a satisfactory solution for all.
