1. I am pleased to be representing Cornwall's Secondary Schools at the Ofsted South West Regional Conference on Thursday on the theme 'The most able students: under the spotlight'. I have been asked to share our practice with HMI (Her Majesty's Inspectorate) and other South West schools because we are the most successful school in Cornwall for more able students. Thank you to all staff, governors and parents/carers who work together to do the best for all our learners.
2. Last Friday I met with Cornwall's School Improvement Team who again congratulated us on the excellent results for GCSE 2014. The year group entered the school at significantly below average and have left significantly above average, showing that progress made here, or in other words, the 'value added' was very good indeed. There are no underperforming subgroups of learners. The latest data from the Fischer Family Trust acknowledges significant progress above national averages in English language, English literature, maths, core science, French, geography, computer science, art, textiles and resistant materials. There are no subjects performing significantly below average. This is recognition that the school is excellent for learners of all abilities. Thank you to everyone, including students, for all the hard work.
3. Thank you to Miss Goodwin and Mr Stevenson for accompanying Year 10 and 11 Dance students to Hall for Cornwall last Tuesday to see Ultima Vez. Again it was good to hear how well our students behaved during the trip.
4. Thank you to Mr Kevern for accompanying History students to see an educational performance of 'Hitler on Trial' in Exeter. The aim of this trip was to help students develop their understanding of the use of evidence, to promote their understanding of causation and develop their ability to analyse

historical arguments, as well as help them to revise factual information. Again, our students' behaviour was excellent.

5. Thank you to Mr Libby from Ellie's Haven Charity for visiting us last week and giving an assembly and update on the work of the charity. We were delighted to present a cheque for £662.63 which the students and staff have raised recently.
6. Thank you to Mr Matthews for his assembly on 'prejudice' last week. This is a reminder to all students that racist, homophobic and other inappropriate language should not be used, and if it is, it should be challenged and reported. It is not acceptable to be a silent observer.
7. Thank you to Mrs Owen for arranging for Mr Rupert Taylor, Criminal Barrister, to come into school last week to help prepare the students who are taking part in the Mock Trial Competition and to talk to students about careers in law.
8. Thank you to Mr Sheer for accompanying students to the Year 9 and 10 County Cup Rugby tournament last Thursday. They played well and won 3 of the games but lost 2.
9. Good luck to the GSCE music students who are performing a concert for pupils at Pelynt Primary School on Friday morning.
10. During tutor time this week Years 9, 10 and 11 will focus on recognising extremism and violent behaviours.
