I would like to stress that, in these final weeks, we will obviously expect the same high standards of behaviour, school uniform and positive attitude to remain intact. Any deviation from this will be treated very seriously and may affect an individual's participation in the traditional, positive schedule of events that all Year 11 students would normally engage in.

Prom


May I take this opportunity to remind you that the Year 11 Prom will take place on Friday 29 June at the Hannafore Point Hotel, 6.30pm for 7.30pm, though it is helpful if students start arriving from 6.30pm because of the long delays from Looe Bridge to the hotel. We would respectfully ask observers to be aware of health and safety and keep the road relatively free in order that students can arrive and have their all-important photo taken. There will be a



photographer present throughout the evening and photos can be purchased during the evening or afterwards via a link from the school's website. Students are reminded that we, and the hotel, have a strict no-smoking and no-alcohol policy. Any student who does not comply with these requests will be asked to leave the hotel premises by staff on duty. Once students have arrived in the hotel they are to remain in the areas booked by the school (i.e. the ballroom and dining room) and they must be aware at all times that the Hannaford Point Hotel will be operating as normal with customers present, as well as staff and students from the school.
