Mercian Developments, on behalf of Tesco, hired the Gallery for two days last week in order to consult the residents of Looe regarding their proposals to build a supermarket and housing opposite the school in Barbican Road. We have some feedback forms left here by them which people can use to express their views. The Governors and I have expressed our concern over the unsuitability of being opposite the school with regard to road safety, traffic congestion and safeguarding our students. I am concerned about losing the feel of a rural environment around the school. Cornwall Council approved the route of the footpath for Barrett homes despite our concerns and it will be some time before the ‘compensation’ land at the end of the rugby field will be useable. As with the Barrett development, any section 106 money for education, associated with new building, will go direct to Cornwall Council. There are no proposals from Tesco to compensate or add to the school in any way.
8. Governors will be discussing school uniform this next week prior to consulting with students, parents/carers and staff.

9. Please would all tutors forward to me by 9am on Tuesday your group's feedback following tutor group discussions on 'what does ready to learn mean' and 'if you wanted to give the impression that you were ready to learn through your appearance, what would you look like?'
